



YEAR 7 CURRICULUM

Curriculum

Year 7 students study a broad curriculum including:

- Art
- Design and Technology
- Drama
- English
- Geography
- History
- Computer Science
- Mathematics
- Modern Foreign Languages
- Music
- Physical Education
- PSHE
- R.E.
- Science

Students are arranged into year group based tutor groups upon entry to the school and work with their form tutor to establish good routines towards school, homework and independent study. In Years 7-9 students also follow a programme of Character Education sessions with their form tutor in order to support their understanding of the world around them, their place within it and how they can look to make the most of opportunities for them within their community. Weekly assemblies further support this work with a moral, ethical, social or community theme. At times, year groups benefit from specific age-related support in assembly such as revision assemblies, exploration of relevant health and lifestyle and celebrations of recent events and efforts from students in the year group.

Students in Year 7 are also organised into mixed attainment teaching groups for many of their subjects covering around half of their timetable; some subjects split these down into smaller groups or group students by prior attainment.
